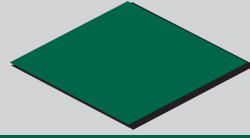

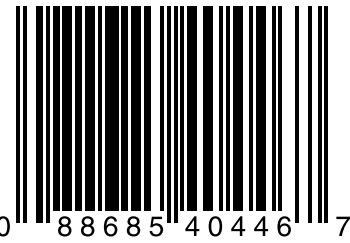

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR ESTABLISHED LAWNS: Apply this product in the Fall (September-October) to produce strong vigorous turf which will over-winter in a healthy condition. Make this product a part of your total lawn fertilizing program.
FOR NEW SEEDING OR SODDING: Use suggested spreader setting for established lawns but go over the area to be seeded twice (once in each direction). Work thoroughly into soil before seeding or sodding.

NOTE: Supplemental applications of lawn fertilizer are needed to achieve a minimum 1 lb. Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft.

These settings were calibrated and field tested. However, age and condition of spreader, speed of operation and evenness of terrain may require slightly different settings for desired coverage.

Apply only to actively growing turf. Do not exceed 3.2 lbs. of total nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. annually.

In Maryland, New Jersey, New York and Virginia: This fertilizer contains phosphorus and may not be used for lawn maintenance on turf in the states of Maryland, New Jersey, New York or Virginia except when

- 1) Providing nutrients to specific soils and target vegetation as determined to be necessary in accordance with a soil test that was conducted by a laboratory* performed no more than 3 years before the application

 - 3) Re-establishing or repairing a turf area.
- *In Maryland, the soil testing laboratory must be identified under Section 8-803.7 of the Agriculture Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

In New Hampshire: This fertilizer contains phosphate. In New Hampshire, phosphate fertilizers may only be used for turf maintenance in golf courses, parks, athletic fields, and sod farms.

In Pennsylvania: Do not exceed 0.9 lbs of total nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per application.
