DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply only as directed.

LawnPlex® is a chelate of iron citrate complex that provides a high concentrate of iron in a soluble form readily available for plant intake through the leaves and soil. **LawnPlex®** is formulated for a soil or foliar application. It is designed to supplement all fertilizer programs with an effective iron treatment for better color. **Use LawnPlex®** in conjunction with the recommendations of your approved nutrient management plan. Low moisture conditions may limit nutrient uptake so a minimum dilution of 1:100 in water is necessary. Maximum dilution should not exceed 1:500. Shake or agitate before adding to tank mix. See compatibility section for details & problems on mixing and applying.

Compatibility: **LawnPlex®** is tank mix compatible with most soluble fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides, and fungicides. However, test any alkaline materials (pH 10 or above) before tank mixing. Mixing with other chemicals may cause staining, so it may be necessary to do a test of the final tank mix on a small concentrate area. If in doubt, call 800-233-1067.

STORAGE: AVOID EXCESSIVE HEAT AND FREEZING. (Store & transport between 40 F° & 90° F or 4 C° & 32 C°.) Some settling of solids may occur: agitate or shake container to achieve complete solubility.

TURF

Lawns, Parks, Sports Fields.....1 1/2 - 2 fl. oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. (1/2 - 2/3 gallon per acre).
Apply every 4 weeks or as needed.
2 1/2 gallon container treats up to 5 acres.

TREES/TRANSPLANTS

Injection Root Feeding.....1 gallon to 100 gallons water. Apply in spring or fall

MAINTENANCE

Foliar Spray.....32 fl. oz./100 gallons water. Apply in spring, summer and fall
